Dear friends,

this year has been a period of intense and sustained work for us. Vladimir Putin and his inner circle expected that after the murder of Alexei Navalny, his team would weaken and people would be intimidated into inaction. But that did not happen.

We publish investigations, run political campaigns, push for sanctions, support political prisoners, analyze public opinion, and tell the truth about Russia — both to domestic and international audiences.

This report outlines the key figures, facts, projects, and results of our work in 2025.

None of this would have been possible without the donations of our supporters, the help of volunteers, and the daily efforts of a team that continues the fight for a free and peaceful Russia.

The Largest Theft in Russia's Defense Sector: Nikolai Kolesov

Nikolai Kolesov is one of the key figures in Russia's defense industry. The ACF has revealed how a system of personal enrichment was built around state-owned defense enterprises.

Following the investigation, ACF launched a campaign calling for the seizure of Kolesov's property in Spain, accompanied by public protests.

Spanish authorities later froze the assets on suspicion of money laundering, and in March 2026 police carried out searches at Kolesov's villas in Mallorca.



The Kolesov case became a clear example of how ACF investigations lead not only to public exposure, but also to tangible consequences.

Poisoning of Alexei Navalny

Putin murdered Alexei Navalny in a penal colony beyond the Arctic Circle, and we are doing everything we can to uncover the full details of this killing and identify everyone involved.

In 2025, we released the video “What Was Navalny Poisoned With?”, which presents new evidence about Alexei’s final hours and how the circumstances of his death were concealed.



In the same video, Yulia Navalnaya spoke for the first time about biological samples that were taken out of Russia and analyzed in foreign laboratories.



As early as 2026, representatives of five European countries issued a joint statement saying that biological samples indicated epibatidine poisoning.

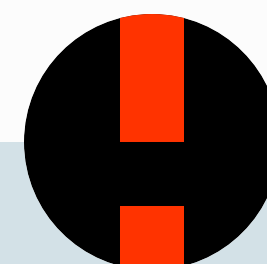
ACF's YouTube channels remain one of our key tools.

Our goal remains the same: to tell Russians the truth, break the monopoly of state propaganda, and offer people an honest, independent perspective on the situation in Russia and the world.

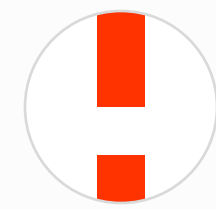

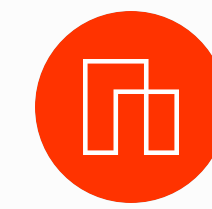

In 2025, we continued to actively develop our presence on TikTok — a platform that is becoming increasingly valuable for us amid the blocking of YouTube.

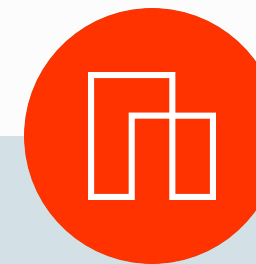
TikTok is especially important because it is widely used by younger audiences. We speak to them in a language they understand and in a format they are familiar with.

In 2025, we ran targeted campaigns against specific members of Putin’s elite, pushing for asset seizures, the cancellation of appearances by regime affiliates, and the imposition of personal sanctions.

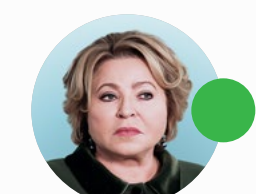

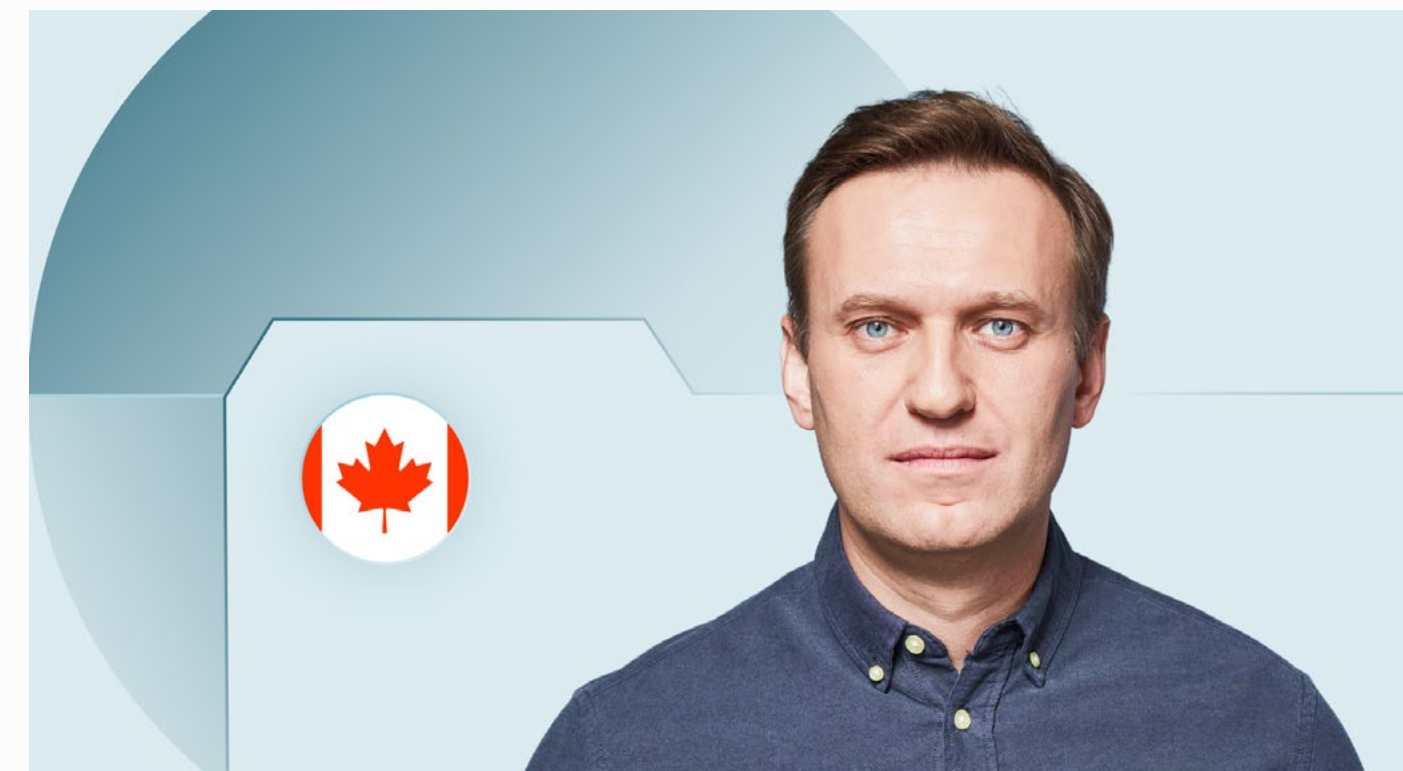

Navalny's list

In 2025, we focused our efforts on specific priority lists — the Lists of 50.

Each list contains 50 individuals closest to Putin, the majority of whom remain unsanctioned in certain jurisdictions.



Sanctions on listed individuals

Canada adopted the List of 50 we prepared in full, even preserving the order of names.

Those sanctioned include Putin's friends, relatives, and close associates, as well as major oligarchs, propagandists, and officials who serve the regime.

AGAINST UNITED RUSSIA



In 2025, Yulia Navalnaya launched a large-scale campaign against United Russia. Putin's party passes laws that enable him to wage war, intensify repression, and dismantle the healthcare, education, and housing and utilities — and, more broadly, normal life in the country.

Parliamentary elections to the State Duma are scheduled for September 2026. Although the results will, as usual, be manipulated, even the most apolitical citizens will be watching. This makes it the best moment to draw attention to United Russia's role in the crimes committed against the country.

As part of the campaign, we run a Telegram channel and produce short-form videos for TikTok.

Several regional opposition initiatives from across Russia have joined the campaign.

POLLS AND SURVEYS

ACF's polls & surveys team continues its work, monitoring public opinion even under conditions of dictatorship. People are afraid to speak openly, so we ask only safe questions in order to obtain reliable data.

In 2025, we continued to measure Russians' attitudes toward the war, the economic situation, and the country's future. The results of these surveys help us better understand the state of Russian society and build political strategy based on reality, not assumptions.

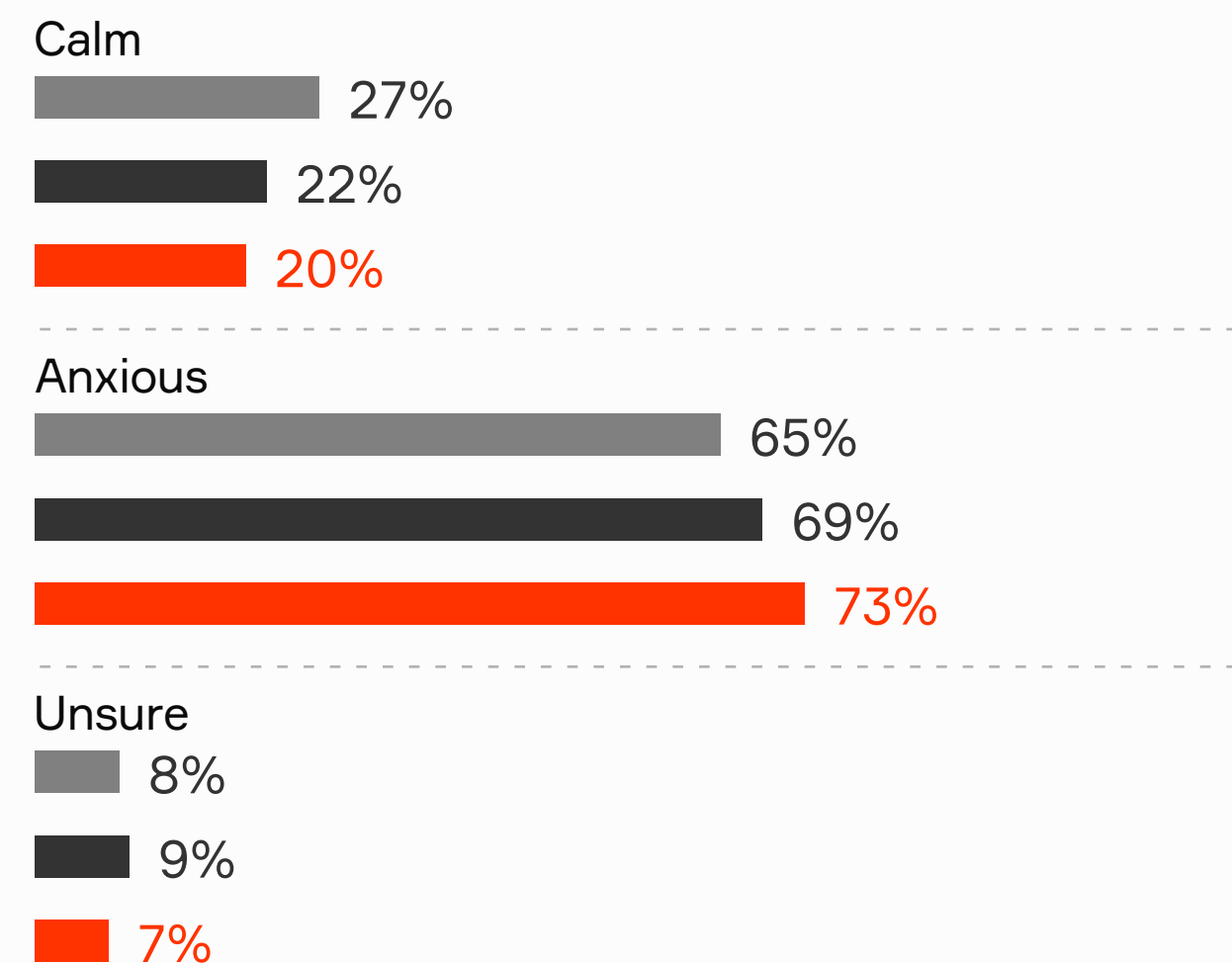

What mood do you think predominates in our country today — calm or anxious?

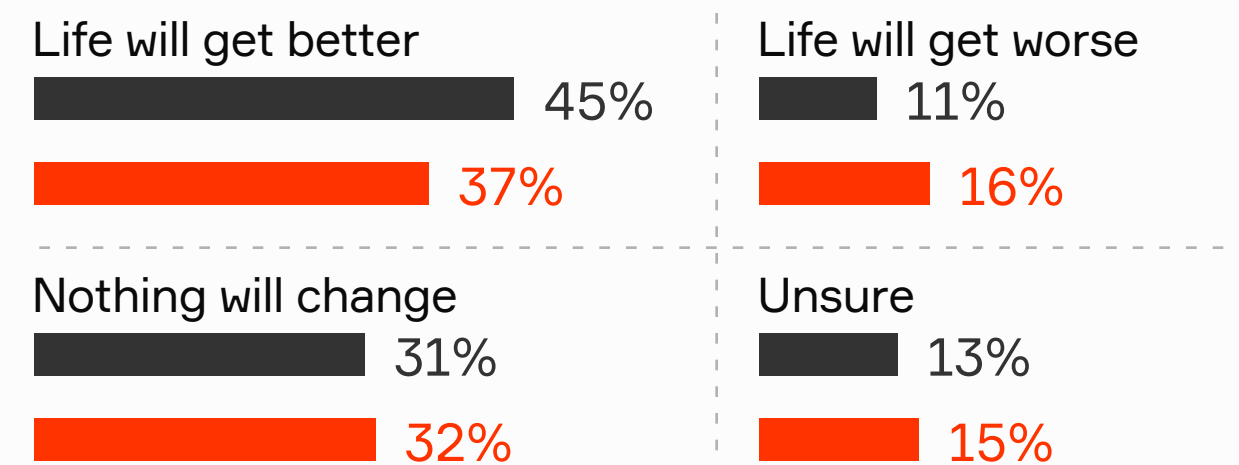

Will your life — and your family’s life — be better than today in six months to a year, worse, or stay the same?

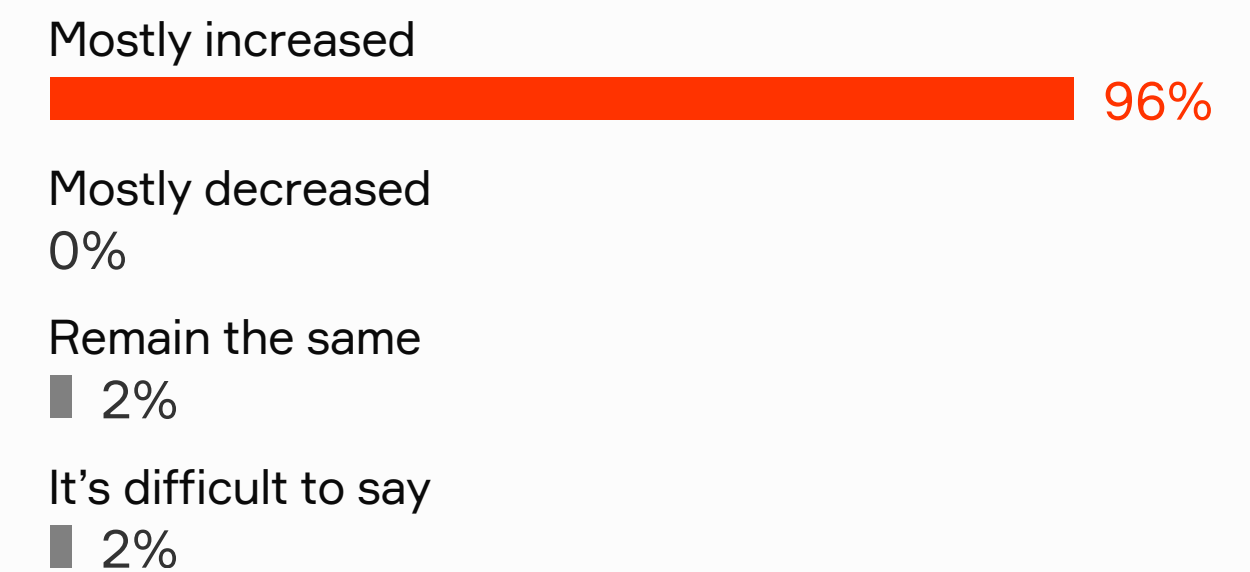

January 2025

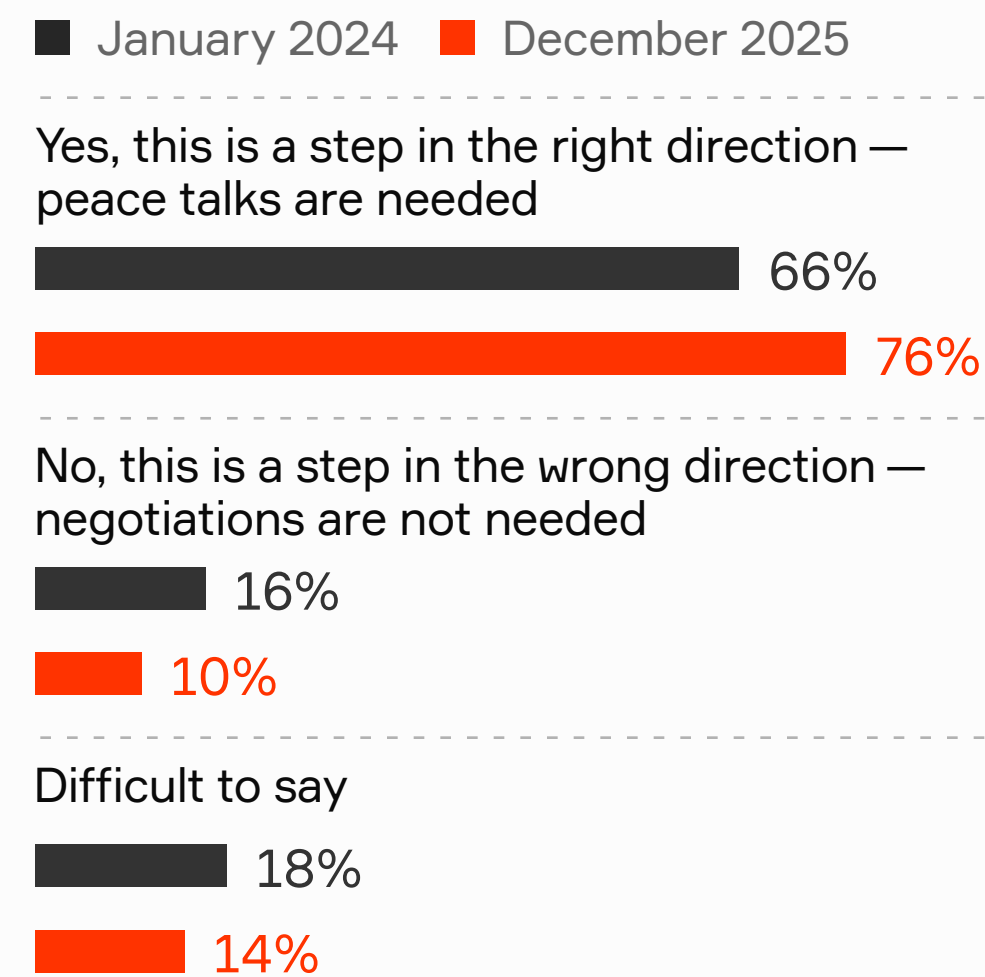

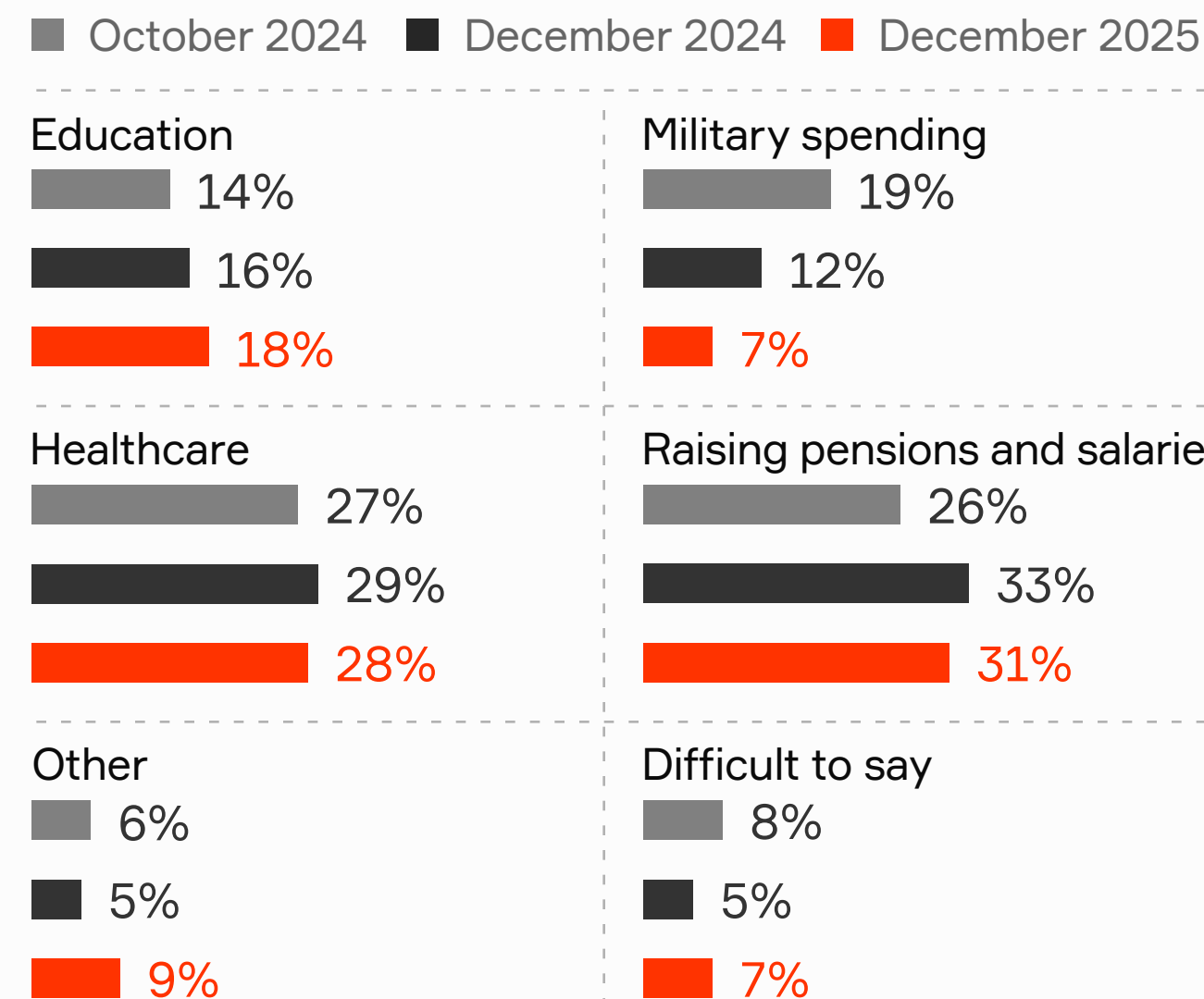
76% support peace negotiations. Putin is responsible for the daily loss of countless lives in a war that serves no real purpose.

The media are reporting on possible peace talks with Ukraine. Do you think this is a step in the right direction or the wrong one?



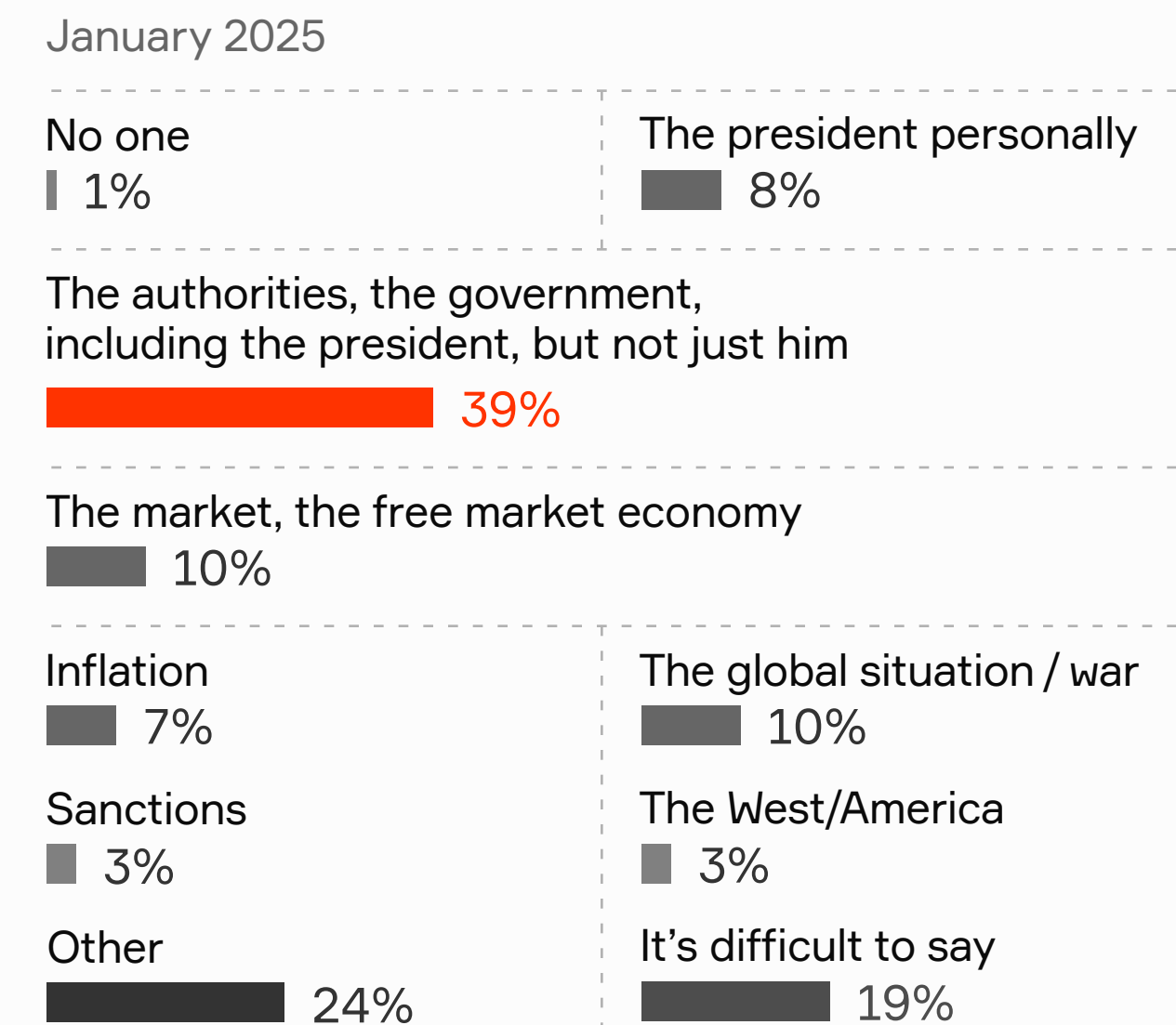
Only 7% believe that money should be spent on the war. An overwhelming majority of Russians believe that the country has enough internal problems that need to be resolved.

LEGAL WORK



ACF's legal team supports those facing political pressure, the threat of military draft, and repression. We continue to pay fines issued for participation in anti-war street protests.

We also support Russians who have left the country due to repression. These documents help individuals who have fled Russia and need evidence of persecution to apply for asylum.

Victory over Putin in Court

The European Court of Human Rights ruled in favor of Alexei Navalny and the Anti-Corruption Foundation.

The case combined 139 complaints filed by Alexei himself, ACF, and our supporters. We won in court, and the judgment explicitly states that the authorities' actions were politically motivated and aimed at putting pressure on the opposition.

The ECHR also ruled in our favor in a number of other cases

- a lawsuit by Putin associate Usmanov over so-called “honor and dignity”;
- a lawsuit by a company linked to Medvedev concerning the investigation “He Is Not Dimon to You”;
- a lawsuit by United Russia politician Metelsky;
- a lawsuit by oligarch Deripaska related to the investigation into Deputy Prime Minister Prikhodko;
- a lawsuit by Putin ally Yevgeny Prigozhin concerning our investigation into poisonings in Moscow schools.

Military Draft Bot

We continue to support Russians who want to avoid participating in the criminal war.

SUPPORTING POLITICAL PRISONERS

Support for political prisoners remains one of our key priorities. People imprisoned for their anti-war and anti-Putin views must not be left alone to face the system.

Together with major media outlets, we launched the political prisoners support fund june12.io and hold an annual fundraising marathon on June 12.

In addition, we organized a special badminton tournament and donated all proceeds to the political prisoners support fund.

These funds were used to provide targeted assistance, including:

- covering the cost of prison parcels;
- supporting the families of political prisoners;
- topping up FSIN (prison service) accounts;
- paying for legal representation in emergency cases;
- providing one-time assistance to released political prisoners;
- evacuations from Russia;
- covering medical expenses.

BLACK BOOK



Black Book is an ACF project that collects and publishes information about judges, prosecutors, investigators, and other officials involved in political repression in Russia.

Our goal is to ensure that no participant in the repressive system can hide behind the anonymity of their position.

Behind every unlawful sentence, arrest, fabricated case, and act of pressure against individuals are specific names.

PRICES TODAY

Prices Today is a project focused on real inflation and the decline in living standards in Russia.

While the authorities speak of stability and low inflation, we collect data that shows how food prices are actually rising and how the war is making people poorer.

8,000

products across 13 online stores in Moscow were tracked by the “Prices Today” project in 2025

Our team regularly monitors prices and tracks changes in the cost of basic goods in major retail chains. This allows us to see the real picture — not through official reports, but through people’s everyday lives.

We also began monitoring food prices in several regions of Russia, including Perm Krai, Chuvashia, Udmurtia, and the Voronezh, Tyumen, and Belgorod regions.

We produced price analyses for New Year’s goods, back-to-school items, a basic food basket, and other product categories.

PROTEST RALLIES

In 2025, supporters of ACF and Alexei Navalny continued to take part in protests and solidarity actions around the world.

These actions are an important way to show that resistance to Putin continues and that Alexei's memory lives on.

We co-organized a major protest on March 1 in Berlin and other cities.

The event was both an anti-war protest and a reminder to the world that Vladimir Putin murdered Alexei Navalny, is carrying out mass political repression, and is destroying our country.

WAR CALCULATOR

War Calculator is an ACF project in which we calculated how much money the Russian state spends on the war — and what those same funds could have been used for inside the country.

On the website, abstract budget trillions are translated into clear, understandable terms.

This project is especially important for those who still do not grasp the true cost of the war. The War Calculator makes it visible — in terms of schools, hospitals, roads, social payments, infrastructure, and lost opportunities.

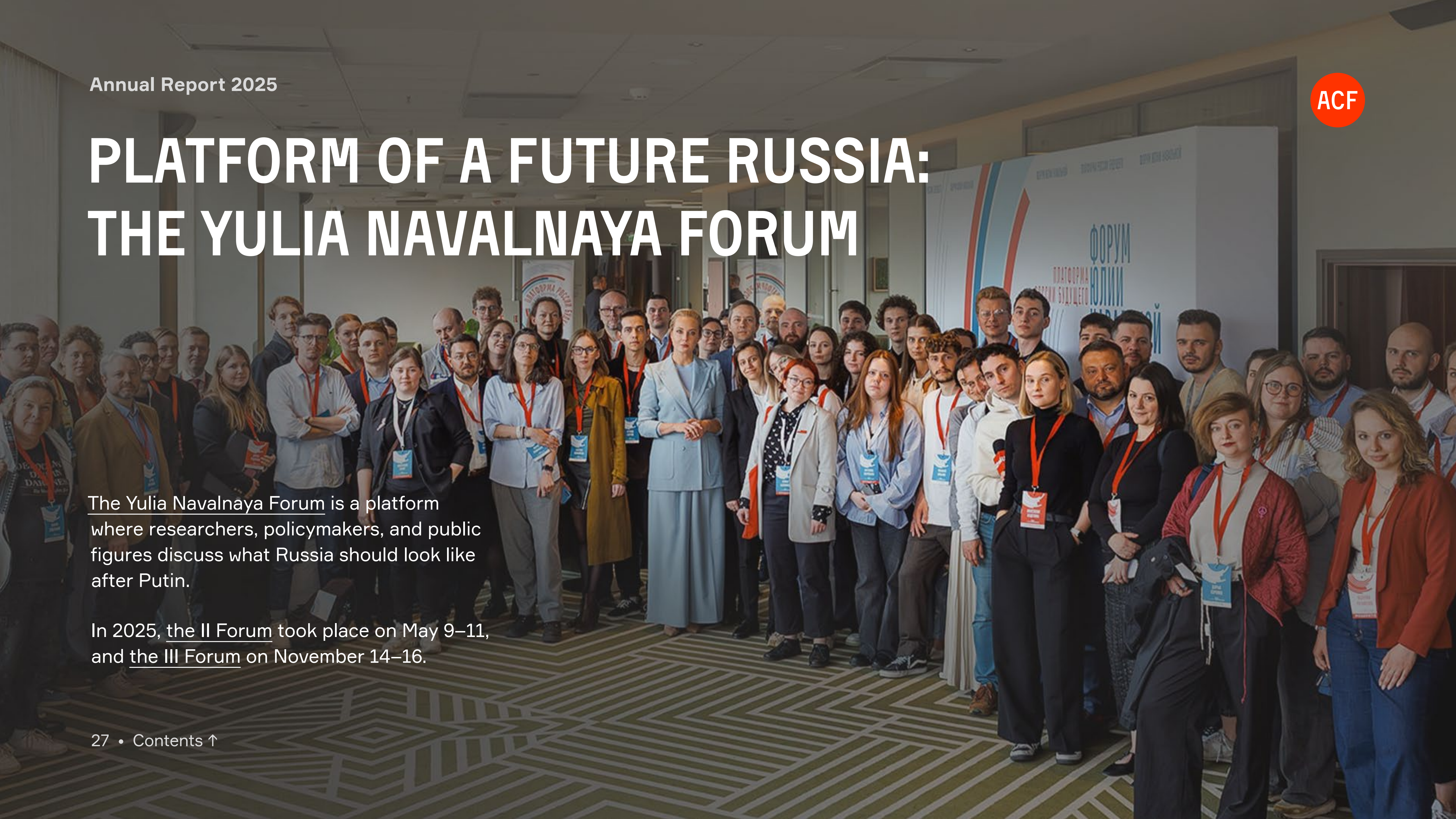

PLATFORM OF A FUTURE RUSSIA: THE YULIA NAVALNAYA FORUM

The Yulia Navalnaya Forum is a platform where researchers, policymakers, and public figures discuss what Russia should look like after Putin.

In 2025, the II Forum took place on May 9–11, and the III Forum on November 14–16.





The second forum

The second forum covered a wide range of topics, including federalism and local self-government, reform of law enforcement and security services, a free economy, media and counter-propaganda, labor rights and solidarity, military reform, and school education.



Student participation

In 2025, the project introduced a new track focused on involving students in the Forum's work, with the opportunity to later complete internships at ACF.

Young people will be the ones building Russia's future, which makes their participation in discussions about that future especially important.



The third forum

The third forum focused on the transition economy, as well as on security and justice, international cooperation, the future architecture of governance, and public participation in the process.

THE ALEXEI NAVALNY PRIZE



An annual award honouring those whose ideas and actions are changing Russia for the better.

Inspired by Alexei Navalny's belief that change begins with small, purposeful steps, the Prize recognizes individuals and grassroots initiatives that advance the cause of a free, democratic Russia and support Russian civil society.

In 2025, Yulia Navalnaya awarded the first Alexei Navalny Prize to the mutual aid platform Zaodno.

The project supports individuals facing politically motivated persecution in Russia. It provides a safe way of raising funds in Russia for their legal defence, fines, assistance to families, and other urgent needs.

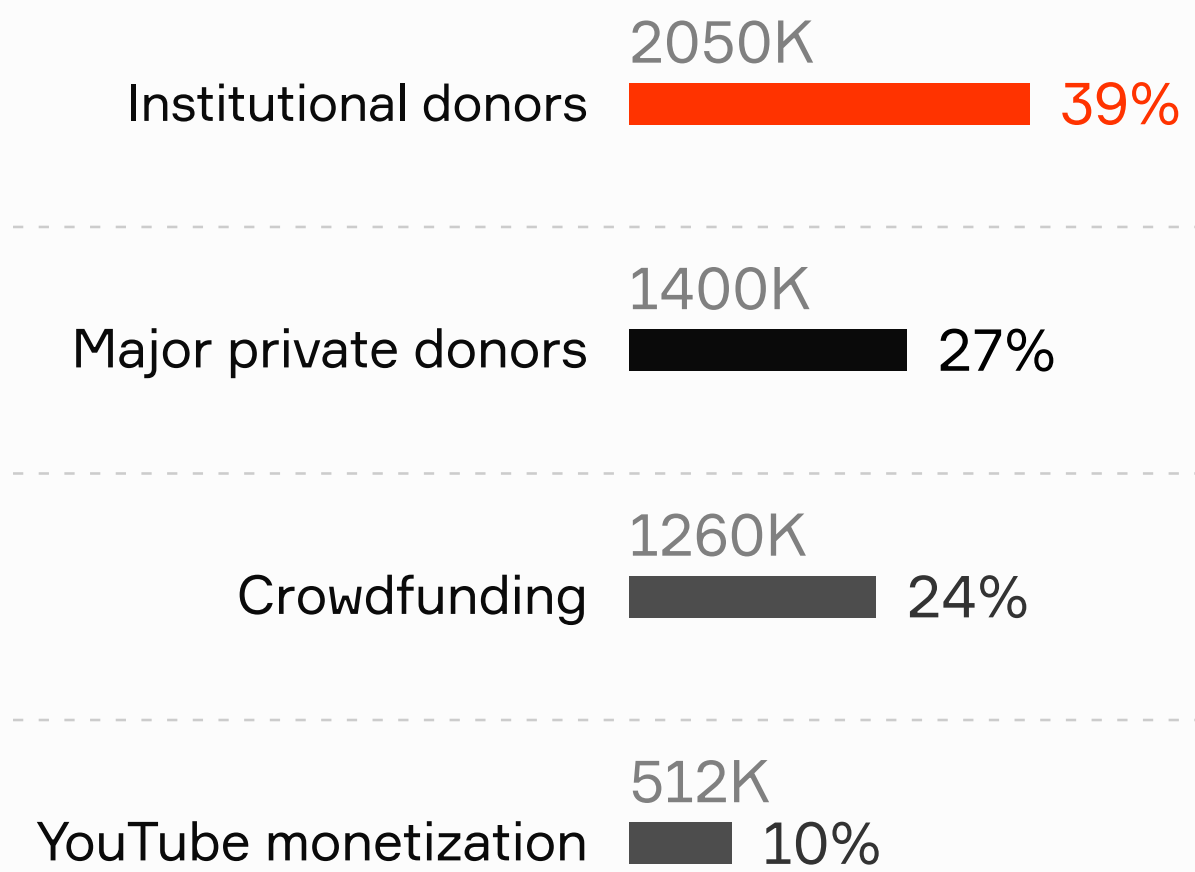
FINANCES

At the same time, we’re grateful to every one of you: even a small donation is a sign of your trust—and that’s what we value most.



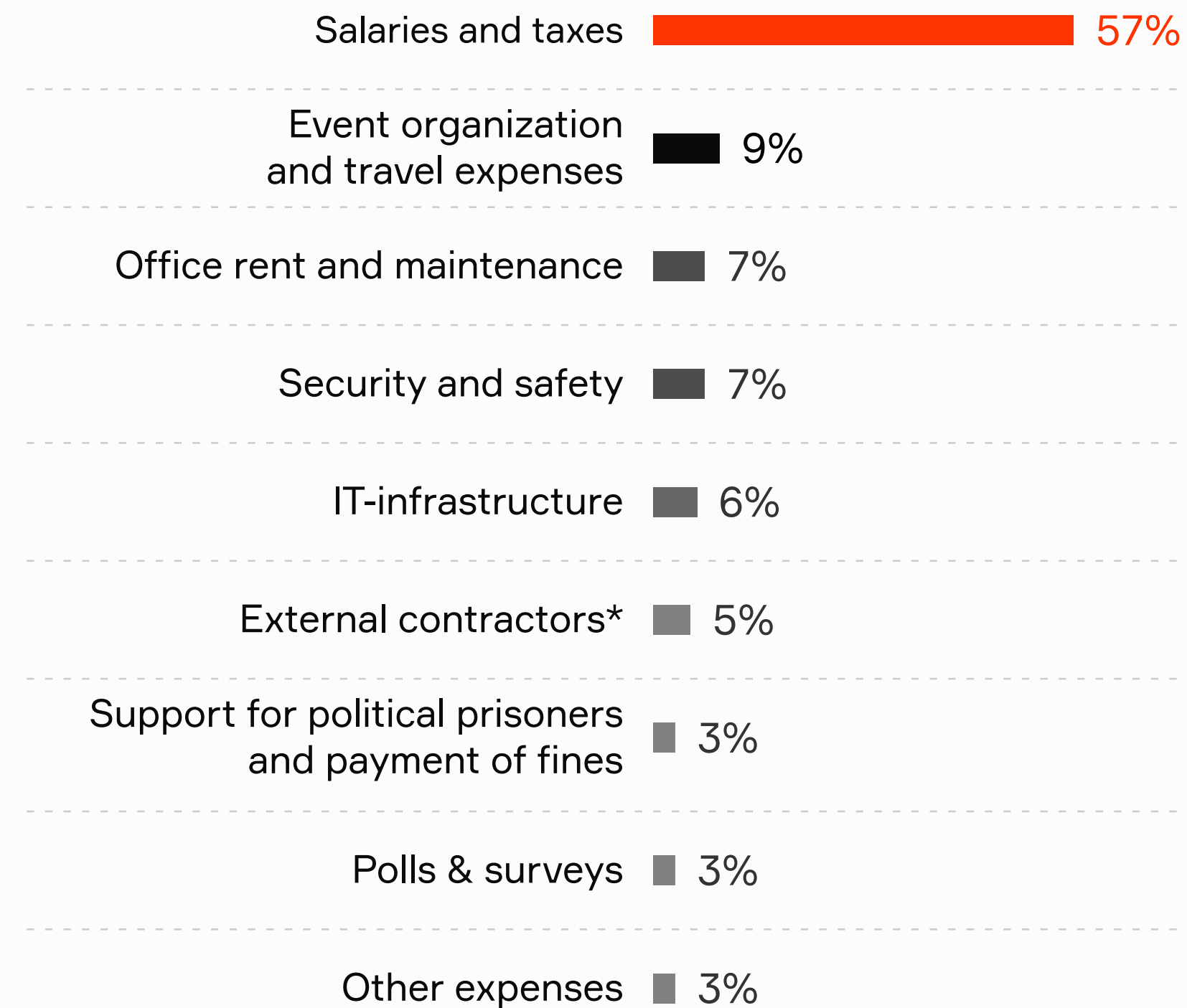
Amounts in US dollars
